

Royal Adelaide Hospital – Colorectal Research Fellow Position (Part-time clinical)

Job Expectations

Part-time research: approx. 60% of working week

- Aim for 3 peer reviewed publications in 12 months.
- Dedicated weekly meeting with research supervisors.
- Presentation at University journal club / national and international meetings.
- Opportunity to extend to Masters degree at the University of Adelaide (supervised by Dr Michelle Thomas and A/P Tarik Sammour).

Casual clinical work (Royal Adelaide Hospital):

- Acute on-call fellow cover (3 nights per month and annual leave cover).
- One weekend ward round per month on colorectal inpatients.

Private assisting (St Andrew's Hospital)

- Private list => average 2 half-days per week.
